Feathermeal provides the slow release nitrogen form, however combined with Blood Meal will also deliver an upfront nitrogen release. Sulphate of Potash ensures the flowers and fruit keep coming.

Not only is Natives & Shrubs perfect for all your Natives including Bottlebrush, Grevillea, Protea, Kangaroo Paw Plants Shrubs and Native Grasses, but can be used in the whole garden. APPLICATION RATES

NATIVE & SHRUBS GENERAL RATES

GENERAL: 100g - 200g per square metre.

NATIVE TREE & SHRUBS:

Before planting mix 50g with the soil at the base of the planting hole. Spread another 50g on top of the soil and under the mulch. Established - Spread 100g per square metre, away from the trunk and out to the drip line of the plant.

ROSE, FLOWERS & VEGETABLES:

Spread 200g per square metre 1 - 2 weeks before planting. Work into top 5 - 10cm & water. Established - Spread 100g per square metre every 4 - 6 weeks. For annual flowers apply at early bud formation.

FRUIT TREES:

Before planting mix 100g with the soil in the bottom of the planting hole. Spread another 50g around the drip line and cover with mulch. Established - Spread 500g up to 4kg for older trees. For Citrus apply in July, November & March.

Spread 200g per square metre & mix into soil during bed formation. Side dress rows once every 4 - 6 weeks - 75g per metre of row after flowering commences.

VINES & BULBS:

Spread 100g per square metre before planting. Side dress rows once every 4 - 6 weeks - 75g per metre of row after flowering commences.
